**Saturday, May 1, 2010**

**Fall Clean-up**  
**Saturday, October 2, 2010**

To help White Bear Lake residents properly dispose of unwanted items, the City will host a spring and fall clean-up (dates noted above) from 7:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. Proof of residency is required (i.e., utility bill or driver's license).

**Location:**

4200 Hoffman Road  
west side of the intersection of Highway 61 and White Bear Avenue. Vehicle lineup will be on Hoffman Road, south of the Public Works facility, so that traffic on Highway 61 is not blocked.

**Acceptable Items:**

White goods (such as stoves, washers, dryers, refrigerators, residential furnaces, and water heaters), old furniture, fluorescent bulbs, and tires are other examples of items commonly brought to the City clean-up.

**Unacceptable Items:**

Items larger than major appliances will not be accepted; examples include fish houses, boats, side of sheds, and motor oil. No stumps, firewood, or brush may be brought to the site. Household hazardous waste (HHW) will not be accepted at the clean-ups. Ramsey County residents may bring their HHW to one of the sites within Ramsey County ([www.co.ramsey.mn.us](http://www.co.ramsey.mn.us)).

**Fees:**

A fee based on the size and type of load will be charged to help pay disposal costs. IN ADDITION, LARGE LOADS OVER THE SIZE OF A STANDARD PICK-UP TRUCK OR STANDARD SIZE 4' X 8' TRAILER WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED. THOSE LARGE LOADS MAY BE TAKEN DIRECTLY TO THE RDF SITE IN NEWPORT, PHONE 651-458-1270, OR TO VASKO DISPOSAL SOLUTIONS IN ST. PAUL ON COMO AVENUE, PHONE 651-487-8546.
